UPON HEARING Rudolph Burnett, Senior Crown Counsel (Ag) for the Claimant **AND UPON READING** the Without Notice Fixed Date Application filed on the 8th day of March 2022 together with the affidavit of **Kevin Forde**, sworn to and filed on the 8th day of March, 2022 together with the Exhibit attached **AND UPON DETERMINING** that this matter be deemed fit for an urgent hearing


IT IS DECLARED that, pursuant to **sections 8(1)(a) and 10B** of the **Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34**, the Defendant be declared a Terrorist and a Listed Person for the purposes of the **Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34** since on the 7th day of March 2022 he was added to the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List concerning ISIL (DA'ESH) and Al-Qaida.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Service of this Order on the defendant be dispensed with;
2. A Restraining Order be granted pursuant to **section 8(3)(a) and (b)** of the **Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34** to freeze any
 - i. property of the Defendant;
 - ii. property that is wholly or jointly owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the Defendant;
 - iii. property that is derived or generated from other property owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the Defendant;
 - iv. property of a person acting on behalf of, or at the direction of, the Defendant, and

- v. the defendant be prohibited directly or indirectly from possessing, controlling or having access to any property.
3. The Defendant or any person affected hereby may within 60 days of the making of the Order, appeal to the Court of Appeal against the decision of the Judge and shall give the Director of Public Prosecutions at least 14 days' notice of the application;
4. The Registrar of the Supreme Court do serve an Office Copy of the Order on the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) immediately;
5. Pursuant to **section 10(1)** of the **Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34**, the Director of Public Prosecutions shall cause notice of this Order to be published:
 - a. immediately electronically;
 - b. in the Official Gazette as soon as possible and
 - c. in at least two (2) daily newspapers in circulation in Barbados, as soon as possible.
6. Liberty to apply;
7. Costs to be costs in the cause; and
8. Such other Orders as this Honourable Court shall deem fit
